

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLOUCESTER TO SHARPNESS TOWPATH (QUEDGELEY TOWN) (HARDWICKE PARISH) GLOUCESTER CITY

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intend to make an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of the unnumbered and unnamed footpath in Quedgeley Town and Hardwicke Parish forming part of the Gloucester to Sharpness Towpath from Sellars Bridge on Haywicks Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 7962/1350 (Point A on the map) and running in a generally northerly then north-easterly direction for approximately 2.4 kilometres to Rea Bridge on Elmore Lane West at OSGR SO 8065/1502 (Point B) and shown by a solid black line on the map.

The closure is necessary for health and safety reasons whilst improvements are made to the towpath surface.

The Order will come into force on the 11th March 2019 and it is anticipated that the public right of way will close on that day until 5th July 2019. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.


There is no alternative route and no access from Footpath EQU/34 whilst the closure is in place.
