Pound Lane and Green Lane, Hardwicke

Dear Sir/Madam

What: Road closure for drainage works
Where: Pound Lane and Green Lane – see overleaf for details of the exact location
When: 23rd to 30th April from 0830 to 1700 daily (excluding weekends)

On behalf of Gloucestershire County Council, we will shortly be installing new drainage headwalls at two locations in Hardwicke, as detailed above.

To ensure the safety of road users and our workforce, it will be necessary for us to **close the road to through traffic at both locations** because of the size of machinery that will be used. Overleaf is a map showing the extents of both the road closure and work areas.

To minimise disruption, the works will be undertaken in two phases. Once Phase 1 is complete we will move on to Phase 2 so both roads are not closed simultaneously:

- Phase 1 – Pound Lane - road closed to through traffic from the junction with the A38 to the junction with Stank Lane
- Phase 2 – Green Lane - road closed to through traffic from the junction with Bristol Road to the junction with Church Lane

We are unable to specify exactly when this switch between phases will happen, but will only close one road (phase) at a time. During each road closure we will do all we can to maintain access for residents and businesses from one direction or the other. However please allow extra time for your journeys if you travel to/from your property during our operational times.

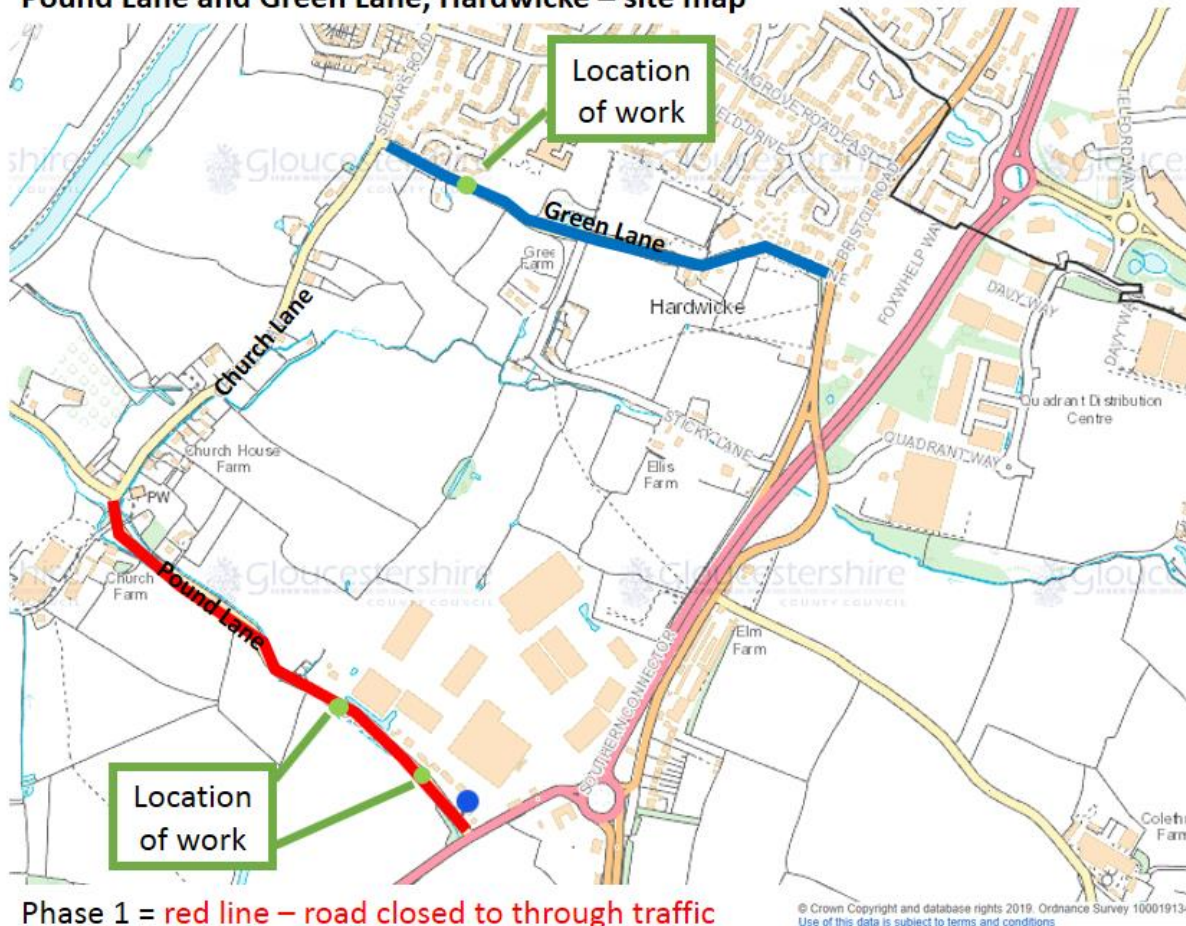
