Tritax Park Gloucester: Highway Improvement Programme Update

I am writing to provide an update on a forthcoming programme of road works related to the construction of the Tritax Park Gloucester development. The next phase of works forms part of the wider Section 278 highway improvements required to support the development.

A programme of works to construct the new Primary Access from Gloucester Road (B4008) is scheduled to commence on 1 September 2026 and continue until 14 December 2026. These works will include construction of the new site access, carriageway widening, drainage installation, kerbing, footways, street lighting and associated utility diversion works.

To carry out these works safely, the following traffic management will be in place:

- Two-way temporary traffic signals operating on the B4008 throughout the works period.
- Temporary lane restrictions within the works area as construction progresses.
- Access to local businesses and properties will be maintained wherever possible.

Following a planned Christmas embargo period, works are currently scheduled to recommence in January 2027 with the next phase of highway improvements along the northbound verge of the B4008. This phase will require three-way temporary traffic signals and is expected to continue until March 2027. Further updates will be issued in advance of these works commencing.

We would like to reassure you that Tritax Big Box, Winvic and all of the contractors involved in the project will work to ensure any disruption to road users and local businesses is minimised.
